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IPP or PEP Goals and Objectives

We believe that every child should have a personalized learning plan that represents their unique strengths, needs and areas of growth. At our school students, parents, teachers and sometimes outside specialists work in collaboration to develop individualized goals for each student. This is one form of assessment that will be paired with their narrative report cards.

An Individual Program Plan (IPP) is a legal document that is most often tied to a psyched assessment, medical assessment or documented special need.

Personalized Educational Plans (PEP) are very similar to IPPs but are not considered legal documents and are most often created for learners who do not have an assessment or documented special need.

The school's job is to facilitate and assist each student in reaching these educational goals once finalized in the IPP or PEP document.

In collaboration with your child, please begin to brainstorm and consider what you would like to see your student accomplish this semester. Goals should be *meaningful*, *measurable and manageable* and should include both academic and social-emotional goals. Typically there are 1-3 goals under each section each semester. You can write down your goals in point-form on the next page or print and attach a separate sheet if you need more space.

Your child's teacher will connect with you and your student in September to further discuss and define your goals and add any connections to the requirements of Alberta Education.

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Student Rights and Responsibilities Contract

- 1. I understand that I have a right to learn in the classroom.
 - It is **my responsibility** to participate and behave in a way that supports a positive, inclusive, safe and productive learning environment for myself and others.
- 2. I understand that I have a right to be heard and listened to in the classroom.
 - It is **my responsibility** to respect my peers and my teacher by listening to them when it is their turn to share or speak.
- 3. I understand that I have a right to feel respected and safe in my classroom and at school.
 - It is my responsibility to be respectful, compassionate, empathetic and kind to others.
 - It is also **my responsibility** to ensure I do not use language that is threatening, vulgar, judgemental or will purposefully make others feel hurt or unsafe.
 - It is also **my responsibility** to avoid touching others for any reason without consent, to not threaten or scare someone with physical or emotional harm and to not physically hurt others.
- 4. I understand that I have a right to feel safe online and when using technology.
 - It is **my responsibility** to understand that technology is to be used for educational purposes only while at school and that it is a privilege that requires that I follow rules of conduct. The rules include that I will **not**:
 - Engage in cyber bullying or write anything that would cause harm or purposefully hurt the feelings of others. (*Please report anything you are concerned about to your teacher.*)
 - Impersonate or falsely represent (pretend to be) the school or others.
 - Hack to gain access to confidential information.
 - Access unprofessional, inappropriate or adult content. (Please tell a teacher immediately if this happens by accident).
 - Engage in any kind of online interactions, chats or conversations with strangers of any age.
 - Write negative comments or give negative reviews about the school or others in our school community on any public forums, websites or social media pages. (Concerns should be brought to the Head of School).
 - It is my responsibility to act with integrity and accept the consequences that I
 will not be allowed to use technology at school if I do not follow the technology
 rules of conduct.

- 5. I understand that I have a right to privacy, personal space and a learning environment that is clean and cared for.
 - It is **my responsibility** to respect the privacy and personal property of others.
 - It is **my responsibility** to respect and care for the property of the school, my learning spaces and school common areas.
- 6. I understand that I have a right to choose how I behave.
 - It is my responsibility to act with integrity and make the appropriate reparations and/or accept the consequences of my actions when I make a poor choice or mistake.
